The school is pursuing authorization as an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School. The International Baccalaureate aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.



Head of School Lisa Nagel notes that the IB mission "reflects many facets of our school's approach to teaching and learning. We see numerous points of intersection between the IB philosophy and our Episcopal identity, and our staff is excited to deepen their practice with a program that prepares students to participate in a global community."
