- Number of Works:** Eight (8) maximum per school
- Age Groups:** Grades 4-6: Two-dimensional Art Grades 4-6: Three-dimensional Art
Grades 7-8: Two-dimensional Art Grades 7-8: Three-dimensional Art
- Restrictions/Limitations:** Size limitation for two-dimensional art is 24" x 36"
Two-dimensional work must be matted with posterboard type paper or mounted on foam core or construction paper
Artwork is to be produced by one student in a school classroom setting.
Work should be identified clearly on the back as follows:

 - Student's Grade
 - Student's Age
