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Number of Works: Ten (10) maximum per school:

(five entries for grades 4-6 & five entries for grades 7-8)

Art Exhibit Categories: Grades 4-6: Two-dimensional Art

Grades 7-8: Two-dimensional Art

Grades 4-6: Three-dimensional Art Grades 7-8: Three-dimensional Art

- > Judges: Please indicate on the Registration Form the names of the faculty who will participate on the judging panel for *both* grade level events.
- For each age group, awards will be presented to the top three individuals/projects.

RULES AND PROCEDURES

<u>Two-Dimensional Art Restrictions:</u> No artwork larger than 24" x 36" and it must be matted with poster board type paper or mounted on foam core or construction paper. Two-dimensional art should be produced by one student in a school classroom setting.

<u>Three-Dimensional Restrictions:</u> Three-dimensional art should be produced by one student in a school classroom setting.

All art should be identified clearly as follows (on the back of the artwork for 2-D and bottom of the artwork for 3-D):

- Student's Name
- School Name
- Student's Grade
- Project Description

Submit Artwork: 8:30 a.m. – 9:15 a.m.

Judging: All artwork will be judged from 9:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

The artwork will be open for viewing by the public from 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Judging Criteria: See attached Rubric for specific criteria
